To this end, we are pleased to announce the holding of these doctoriales on **June 16 & 17, 2022** in the conference center of the University.

This scientific event will be an invaluable opportunity for exchanges between professors and doctoral students from different disciplines including law, economics and management. The ultimate objective of this meeting would be to allow doctoral students from different institutions in the Kingdom to present the progress of their respective research work in front of a jury made up of senior professors, thus benefiting from their scientific advice and guidance in instantaneous way and without intermediary.

This scientific event will therefore represent a meeting place conducive to sharing experiences not only between professors and doctoral students but also between doctoral students from different institutions of the UHP (ENCG, ENSA, Faculty of SJESG).

Indeed, participants will have the opportunity to discuss the state of knowledge in the different disciplinary fields, the available literature and the theoretical underpinnings of the different research questions. It will also be an opportunity to explore the epistemological positions taken, the methodologies adopted and the results obtained by doctoral students who are close to completing their thesis or by those who have just graduated.

This event would therefore be an excellent benchmark and a means of positioning for anyone concerned with perfecting his or her record as a scientific researcher and future expert doctor in the social sciences.

As such, we are honored to invite all doctoral students to participate in this event, which is intended to be enriching, socializing and innovative.

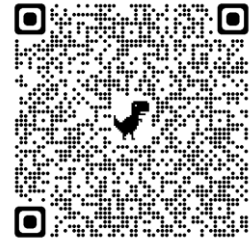
First year doctoral students will be asked to present a poster on their research design or their thesis project. For **second year** doctoral students, it will be a matter of presenting a poster or a slightly more accomplished state of progress of their research and a planning of the next milestones of the project. For the **third year** and above, they will focus on the presentation of a very advanced state of their research and a schedule of the next project milestones.

Research papers can be submitted in French, English or Arabic. Oral presentations will be made in the language of preference.

The time allotted for each oral presentation is 10 to 15 minutes during the workshops followed by 5 minutes of debate and discussion at the end of the presentation.

Writing Standards :

- **For posters (see outline);**
- **For the progress report (see outline);**
- **For communication projects, the writing standards are as follows :**

In accordance with the proposed template, full papers should not exceed 16 pages from the second page to the annexes. A margin of 2.5 cm must be respected on an A4 format. References should be included in the body of the text with a numbered bibliography in ascending order. The font "Times New Roman" should be used for the entire text with a normal line spacing of 1.5. The cover page should not be numbered and should include the following points :

- Title of the thesis;
- Disciplinary field (Law, Economics or Management);
- First and last name ;
- University; Institution; Laboratory;
- Contact information (phone and email);
- An abstract of maximum 250 words, with 3 to 5 keywords.
- All pages must be numbered.
